

**REPORT TO THE

A special meeting of the Board of Carbon County Commissioners (BOCC) commenced Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. at the Carbon County Courthouse, Rawlins, WY. Attending the meeting were; Chairman, John Johnson, Vice Chairman, Sue Jones, John Espy, Travis Moore, and Byron Barkhurst.

Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and said the purpose of the meeting was a budget workshop and to discuss the Courthouse and Carbon Building Project including the temporary space on Murray Street.

BUDGET WORKSHOP

Budgets were discussed and the FY 20-21 budget was balanced.

COURTHOUSE & CARBON BUILDING PROJECT

The BOCC received an estimate from FCI and Jim Piche for modifications to the Interim Justice Center on Murray Street and decided to move forward using Jim's. He will use local and county labor and anticipates he can complete the project by mid-August. His estimate included roof replacement noting he would bid that project later.
