\$600.00 at the regular meeting in Jan. 1912.

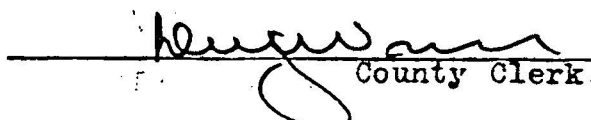
\$600.00 at the regular meeting in Feb. 1912.
