

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUG. 8TH A. D. 1912.

Board met pursuant to adjournment of Aug. 7th. Roll Call showing present Commissioners D. C. Jones, Evan Veitch, Wm A. McKay Chairman and Dee J. Wren, Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Jones that the offer of 30 cents an acre on the mineral reserve assessment, as made by ~~Commissioner~~ Mr. Holcome representing the Union Pacific Railroad Company, be accepted.

Motion declared lost for the want of a second.

Moved by Commissioner Jones that the claim of E. H. Decker in amount of \$750.00 ; for the moving of the building for the poor farm, be allowed and the contract and Bond of said E. H. Decker be cancelled.

Seconded by Commissioner McKay.

Whereupon it was ordered that the Bond and contract be cancelled and the county Clerk directed to issue a Warrant to E. H. Decker in the above mentioned amount of \$750.00.

Board adjourned to 2 o'clock P. M.

Board met pursuant to adjournment of morning session, Roll call showing all members present.

Application of Wm. Kyle for retail Liquor License at the town of Medicine Bow was read for the first reading.

County Treasurer S. Park, made a report in the matter of settlement of the State Tax due from this County, setting forth the following facts.

That in June 1911 he received a request from the State Treasurer to reduce the deficiencies for the years of 1909 and 1910 as soon as possible.

That this was done and the Tax for 1910 was paid.

That the State examiners checked the rebates allowed by Carbon County for the year of 1910, to be ^{amount} in of \$1081.19 for the State's proportion. and the claim was so made of the State.

That the State Treasurer refused to allow said claim setting forth the fact that the account for the year of 1910 had been closed.

That S. Park County Treasurer, personally took the matter up at Cheyenne and succeeded in getting the State Treasurer to so change his books that the amount of \$982.95 could be credited Carbon County, but it being impossible to allow the full ^{amount of} \$1041.19. S. Park County Treasurer accepted the first mentioned amount of \$982.95, and asks that the Board Sanction the settlement

Whereupon it was moved by Commissioner McKay, and Seconded by Commissioner Jones that the sum of ~~\$84~~ 982.95 be accepted for the payment of the State's share of the Rebates allowed by Carbon County for the year of 1910, and that the action of S. Park in accepting same, be and is hereby sanctioned.

Motion declared carried.
