Board met pursuant to adjournment of morning session. Roll call showing all members present. Proceedings were had as follows:-

Owing to the great amount of snow in the eastern part of the County, and the fear that spring thaws, will cause the ~~high~~^e waters in the different strams to be much higher this year than usual, It is hereby ordered, that the County Road Supervisor, hire such help and to make such prepreations as he may deem advisable for the safety of the bridges and culverts in that section of the County.

County Surveyor J. R. E. Turpin having been made or appointed Deputy State Surveyor. He is hereby authorized and directed to survey and lay out the Trans-Continental Road, from the Albany County Line to the Western Boundary of Carbon County. The general course of said road to be along the line now traveled, and near the U. P. Railroad Company's right of Way. There being no further business, adjournment was made to April 2nd. 1912, to meet at that time in regular session, as is by law required.
