## Liquor Licenses.

## Reports.

Report Of S. Park County Treasurer showing a Balance of \$19,319.47 available for current expenses, was received and ordered filed.

In view of the above the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a call for bids for the movement of said above mentioned building to the present County Poor Farm Property a distance of about one half miles.

## Depositories.

Applications of The Rawlins National Bank of Rawlins, The First National Bank of Rawlins, The Stock Growers National Bank of Rawlins, and the Saratoga State Bank of Saratoga, were received, and upon motion made by Commissioner D. C. Jones, Seconded by Commissioners McKay, being duly put and carried, it is hereby ordered that the above mentioned banks be and are hereby designated as Depositories for the County Funds.

It was regularly moved by Commissioner Jones Seconded by Commissioner Veitch, that in addition to the four above mentioned banks, that The First State Bank of Baggs, Stockgrower's Bank of Dixon, and the Carbon State Bank of Hanna, may become depositories upon filing application etc. and complying with the law.

Sale of Property

BE IT RESOLVED, that WHEREAS, lots numbered 19 and 20, block 58 in the Town of Encampment, Wyoming, was sold for taxes July 11th 1906 for the 1905 taxes. and WHEREAS said property was bind in by Carbon County at such sale, and WHEREAS the time for redemption of said land has expired, whereby title to said lands passed into Carbon County, and WHEREAS W. M. Englehart and E. H. Parkison, co-partners, has offered to pay to Carbon County to the amount of said lots No. 19 and 20 Block 58 was sold for together with all interests, costs, taxes assesed against said lands due and remaining unpaid to date and other expenses incurred to date amounting to a total of \$25.92, NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, that the said lands be sold to E. M. Englehart and E. H. Parkison for the said sum of \$25.92 and the Chairman of this Board and the County Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute the proper deed of conveyance to the said property to the said W. M. Englehart and E. H. Parkison.
