


## PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MAY 7TH, 1912.



A deligation representing the interestsof Medicine Bow and vicinity appeared before the Board and asked that a Bridge be put accross the Medicine Bow River a span of about eightty feet. Said bridge being in immediate need, the Board hereby authorizes and directs, that Co. Surveyor J. R. E. Turpin, Road Supervisor John Milliken, and Commissioner D. C. Jones veiw the sight proposed for the bridge and report at the next meeting of the Boafrd.

A petetion was presented by L. D. Peck, asking that a road be established as fo~~ll~~ows. Commencing at a point on the line between B. A. Ridding and ROAD Mrs. C. M<sup>3</sup> Wilcox property, and running thence N 36° 41' E 2230 ft from the South East Corner Sect. Twenty nine (29) Tp. Sixteen (16), North Range Eighty~~four~~ (84), W. 6th P. M. and running thence South 89° 49' E two thousand and fifty (2050) feet to station No. 1 and terminating at the south switch of the S & E. R. R at Cow creek siding having, a ~~with~~ width of thirty (30) feet. ~~Pres~~ Same was ordered fi~~l~~ed for future consideration,
