

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. SEPTEMBER 4th. 1914.

Board met this 4th. day of September A. D. 1914. at 10 o'clock A. M. pursuant to adjournment of September 3rd. 1914. Roll Call showing present, Commissioners D. C. J. Jones, Robt. A. Day, Wm. A. Mc Kay, Chairman and L. B. Magor. Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

The Board proceeded to make the levy for the requisite taxes upon the assessed and taxable property within the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming for the State and School Revenue for the year 1914 as is provided by law.

The statement of the State Auditor was presented, read and ordered filed.

The County Assessor submitted the certified statement from the State Auditor of the State of Wyoming, showing the assessment of said Carbon County, as made by the State Board of Equalization for the year A. D. 1914 and the properties of corporations Railroads, Car and Telegraph Lines as hereinafter set forth, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to add the amounts returned by the State Auditor, to the assessments of said Carbon County for the year of 1914, same being as follows:-

Abstract of assessment roll	\$15,679,163.
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At the meeting of the State Board of Equalization the rate of levy upon each Dollar of valuation for State Revenue for the year 1914 was fixed at .00285 and the Board were thereby directed to make this levy as provided by law.

The amount of State Tax charged to Carbon County for the year of 1914 is \$44,685.61.

It is hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that the following amounts be levied and assessed upon each and every dollar of the taxable, real and personal property in said County and State of Wyoming and upon the assessed valuation thereof as is shown by the assessment roll of said Carbon County, State of Wyoming for the year of 1914, including the valuation of property of Railroad, Car and Telegraph Companies as assessed to them by the State Board of Equalization.

For state Revenue Purposes Two and Eighty-Five hundredths mills. .00285.

For County Revenue for all purposes as is provided in Section 2320 of the Compiled Statutes of Wyoming for 1910, except special levies for the ~~support~~ support of Common Schools and all other Special Levies provided by law; Five and Five tenths mills .0055.

The Clerk is hereby instructed and authorized to place upon the official ballot of the General Election to be held on the 3rd. day of November A.D. 1914 a proposition to be voted on for the purpose of levying an increase of One (1) mill on each dollar valuation for the purpose of constructing a road from the point on the County road near the town of Encampment thence running in a southerly direction to the South County Line of Carbon County, Wyoming. The said proposition on said ballot to be presented in accordance with the law.
