Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

ROAD DISTRICTS.

In Compliance with Section 2547 Session Laws of Wyoming, 1913, regarding to the dividing of the County into Road Districts.

ROAD DISTRICT NO. 1.

Road District No. 1, to comprise the same territory as ~~#####~~ established by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, at their regular meeting held on July, 10 1914.

ROAD DISTRICT NO. 2.

Road District No. 2, to comprise the same territory as established by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, at their regular meeting held on July, 10th. 1914.

ELECTION DISTRICTS.

In compliance with Section 146 of the Compiled Statutes of Wyoming, 1910, the Board established Election Districts as follows:- also Election Precincts in the several Districts.

DISTRICT NO. 1. RAWLINS.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 1.

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Township 24 N. R. 86 W.; thence west along the township lines between townships 24 and 25 to the northwest corner of Township 24 N. R. 89 W.; thence south along the west boundary line of Carbon County to the southwest corner of township 20 N. R. 89 W.; thence east along the township line between township 19 and 20 to the northeast corner of township 19 N. R. 89 W.; thence south on the Range line between Ranges 88 and 89 to the southeast corner of township 16 N. R. 89 W.; thence east to the southeast corner of township 16 N. R. 88 W.; thence north on Range line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the northwest corner of township 17 N. R. 87 W.; thence east along the township line between townships 17 and 18 to the southeast corner of township 18 N. R. 86 W.; thence north to the northwest corner of township 18 N. R. 85 W.; thence east on township line to the southeast corner of township 19 N. R. 85 W.; thence north on the Range line to the southeast corner of Township 20 N. R. 85 W.; thence west on township line to the southeast corner of township 20 N. R. 86 W.; thence north on the range line between ranges 85 and 86 to the northeast corner of township 24 N. R. 86 W.; the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 2. FERRIS AND SEMINOEE

Ferris and Seminoe District No. 2: shall consist of all that territory embraced within the following boundary; Beginning at the southwest corner of Township 25 N. R. 89 W.; thence east on a line between township 24 and 25 to the North Platte River; thence northwesterly along the North Platte River to the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27 N. R. 84 W. thence west along the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. to the line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the line between Carbon and Natrona Counties to the line between Carbon and Fremont Counties; thence south along the west line of Carbon County to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 3. FORT STEELE

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Fort Steele Election District No. 3.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of township 20 on the line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north on said line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the line between townships 24 and 25, thence west along said line between townships 24 and 25 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south along said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence east along said line between townships 19 and 20 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 4. LEO.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Leo Election District No. 4.

Beginning at the southeast corner of township 24 N. R. 81 W/ thence north along the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the north line of Carbon County to the line between ranges 84 and 85; thence south along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 W. to the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W.; thence east along the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. to the North Platte River; thence southeasterly along the North Platte River to the line between townships 24 and 25; thence east along the line between townships 24 and 25 to the Northwest corner of Twp. 24, N. R. 83 W.; thence south to the southwest corner of Twp. 24, N. R. 83 W.; thence east along the line between townships 24 and 25 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 5. MEDICINE BOW.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Medicine Bow Election District No. 5.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Carbon County, Wyoming; thence west along the north boundary line of Carbon County to the Northeast corner of Township 28 N. R. 81 W. thence south along the Range line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the southeast corner of township 24, N. R. 81 W.; thence east along the township line to the northeast corner of township 23 N. R. 80 W.; thence south between the range line 79 and 80 to the southeast corner of township 22 N. R. 80 W.; thence east along the township line between townships 21 and 22 to the east boundary line of Carbon County, Wyoming.; thence north along the east boundary line of Carbon County, Wyoming, to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 6. HANNA.

All that territory embraced in Townships 21, 22 and 23 in Ranges 81, 82 and 83 W. also townships 22 and 23 in Range 80 W. shall be known as Hanna District No. 6.

DISTRICT NO. 7. ELK MOUNTAIN.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Elk Mountain Election District No. 7.

Beginning at the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line between townships 19 and 20; thence north on said eastern boundary line of Carbon County to the line between townships 21 and 22; thence west on said line between townships 21 and 22 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81 W.; thence south on said line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence east on said line between townships 19 and 20 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 8. ROCK DALE.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Rock Dale Election District No. 8.

Beginning on the boundary line between Carbon County and Albany County and on the line between townships 16 and 17; thence north on said County line to the line between townships 19 and 20; thence west on said line between townships 19 and 20 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81; thence south on said line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the line between townships 18 and 19; thence west on said line between townships 18 and 19 to the Range line between Ranges 81 and 82; thence south on said line between Ranges 81 and 82 to the line between townships 17 and 18; thence east on said township line to the line between Ranges 79 and 80; thence south on said line to a point between townships 16 and 17; thence east on said line between townships 16 and 17 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 9. GREEN.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Green Election District No. 9.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Township 19, Range 81 W.; thence north on the line between ranges 80 and 81 to the line between townships 20 and 21; thence west along the line between townships 20 and 21 to the line between ranges 83 and 84; thence south on said line between Ranges 83 and 84 to the line between townships 18 and 19; thence east on said line between townships 18 and 19 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 10. SARATOGA.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Saratoga Election District No. 11.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 1, Township 16, N. R. 83 W.; thence north on line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the line between Townships 17 and 18; thence east on said line between townships 17 and 18 to the line between Ranges 81 and 82; thence north along said line between ranges 81 and 82 to the line between townships 18 and 19; thence west along said line between townships 18 and 19 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on said line between townships 18 and 19 to the line between ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 17 and 18; thence west on said line between townships 17 and 18 to the line between ranges 87 and 88; thence south on said line between ranges 87 and 88 to the line between townships 16 and 17; thence east on said line between townships 16 and 17 to the line between Ranges 83 and 84; thence south on said line between Ranges 83 and 84 to the southwest corner of Section 6, Township 16, N. R. 83 W. the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 11. ENCAMPMENT.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Encampment Election District No. 11.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Township 15, N. R. 83 W.; thence north to the southeast corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 16. N. R. 83 W.; thence west to the southwest corner of Section 6, Twp. 16. N. R. 83 W.; thence north to the Northeast corner of Township 16, N. R. 84 W.; thence west to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 14 and 15; thence due east to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 12. BENNETT.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Bennett Election District No. 12.

Beginning on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line between Townships 14 and 15; thence north on said eastern boundary line of Carbon

County to the line between townships 17 and 18 thence west on said line between townships 17 and 18 to the line between Ranges 82 and 83 W.; thence south on said line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the line between townships 14 and 15; thence east on said line between townships 14 and 15 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 13. COLLINS.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Collins Election District No. 13.

Beginning on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the boundary line of the State of Colorado and Wyoming; thence north on the eastern boundary line of Carbon County to the line between townships 14 and 15; thence west on said line between townships 14 and 15 to the line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence south on said line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the line between Section 19 and 30 Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W. thence east on said line between Sections 19 and 30 to the corner of Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30. Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W.; thence south on said line between Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W. to the township line between townships 13 and 14; thence east on the said township line between townships 13 and 14 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86 W.; thence south on said range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the Colorado State Line; thence east along said Colorado Line to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 14. SNAKE RIVER.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Snake River District No. 14.

Beginning at a point of intersection of the Colorado State Line and the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 13 and 14; thence west on said line between townships 13 and 14 to the section line between sections 31 and 32, Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W.; thence north on said line section line between sections 31 and 32/Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W.; ~~thence~~ to section corner between sections 19, 20, 29 and 30. Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W.; thence west on said section line between Sections 19 and 30 Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W. to the line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence north on said range line between townships 14 and 15 to the range line between ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 16 and 17; thence west on said township line between townships 16 and 17 to the range line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence south on said line between ranges 87 and 88 to the line between townships 15 and 16; thence west on said line between townships 15 and 16 to the dividing line between Carbon and Sweetwater Counties; thence south on said dividing line between Carbon and Sweetwater Counties; ~~thence~~ to the Colorado State Line; thence along said Colorado State Line to the place of beginning.


DISTRICT NO. 15. SULPHUR.

All that territory embraced within Townships 16, 17, 18, and 19, Ranges 89, 90, 91, 92 and 93 W. in Carbon County, Wyoming shall be known as Sulphur Election District No. 15.

DISTRICT NO. 16. WALCOTT.

All that territory embraced within townships 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 N. Range 84 W. shall be known as Walcott Election District No. 16.

Election District No. 16 shall consist of one Election Precinct.

Walcott Precinct No. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 16.

DIFFICULTY PRECINCT. NO. 5.

BE IT RESOLVED that there be and there is hereby created a Polling Precinct to be known as Difficulty Precinct No. 5, in Election District No. 4, to conform with the resolution passed at the meeting of the Board held on October 5th. 1910, said precinct to be taken from Districts Nos. 4 and 5, and embracing Townships 24 and 25 N. Ranges 80 and 81 W. of the 6th. P. M.
