

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SEPTEMBER, 3rd. 1918.

Board met at 10 o'clock A. M. this 3rd day of September A. D. 1918, in regular session as is by law required. Roll call showing present, Andrew W. Rasmussen, D. E. Winsor, Wm. A. Mc Kay, Chairman and L. B. Magor, Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

The Minutes of the previous session were read and approved.

The Board proceeded to make the levy for the requisite taxes upon the assessed and taxable property within the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, for the State, County, City and School Revenue for the year A. D. 1918, as is provided by law.

The statement of the State Auditor was presented, read and ordered filed.

The County Assessor submitted the certified statement from the State Auditor of the State of Wyoming, showing the assessment of said County of Carbon, as made by the State Board of Equalization for the year A. D. 1918, and the properties of Corporations, Railroad, Car and Telegraph Lines as hereinafter set forth, and the County Assessor is hereby instructed to add the amounts returned by the State Auditor, to the assessments of Carbon County for the year A. D. 1918, the same being a total as follows:-

ABSTRACT OF ASSESSMENT ROLL \$19,416,733.84.

At the meeting of the State Board of Equalization the rate of levy upon each Dollar of valuation for State Purposes for the year A. D. 1918, was fixed at Three and Seven Tenths (3.7) Mills, (\$.0037) and the Board were thereby directed to make this levy as provided by law.

The amount of State Tax charged to Carbon County, Wyoming, for the year A. D. 1918, is \$71,841.92.

D. 1918, including the valuation of property of railroad, car and telegraph companies as assessed to them by the State Board of Equalization.
