REPORTS.

Reports of S. Park, County Treasurer, Justices of the Peace P. P. Murphy, Jno. C. Friend, and J. H. Crawford, Z. T. Carver, Deputy County Live Stock Inspector, were read and ordered filed.

A petition from J. R. Rollman in behalf of a number of tax-payers of Platte Valley was filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners, in regard to rebate to the Saratoga-Encampment R. R. Company the full amount of said company's 1920 taxes. The petition was duly read, but no action taken by the board.

Correction of erroneous assessment.

The S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 12, N. Range 90 W. 6th P. M., Carbon County Wyoming were assessed to Bert Vangilder in 1904 and sold to the County at the sale held July 10th, 1905 and have not been redeemed. This property according to the records of the Recorder's office should have been assessed as the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 12, N. Range 90 W. 6th P. M. Resolution was made that the sale of July 10th, 1905 be annuled to clear the title to the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 12, N. Range 91 W.
