Resolved that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, as taken on motion ^{ROAD} duly seconded and passed, on February 6th, A.D.1924, deciding "to close the first railroad crossing west of Hanna and that in the future it be held merely as a private road" be vacated and the ground that the closing of this crossing was obtained by misrepresentation, and for the further reason that such closing was illegal, not having been accomplished under the method required by law. That any gates now closing this crossing are hereby ordered removed and the crossing restored to its former width. This action to be published in the official paper of Carbon County and that due notice be given the Railroad Company.

Motion unanimously carried.
