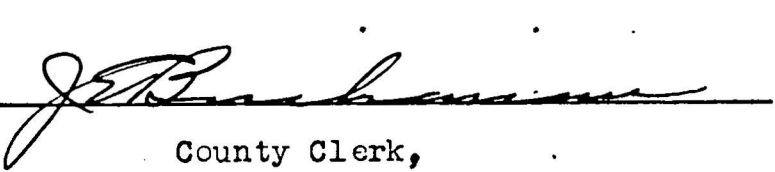

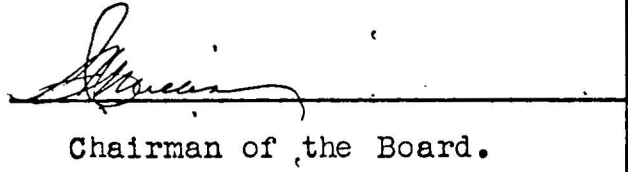
COMMISSIONER'S DEEDS.

By motion duly made and carried, the County Clerk was instructed to furnish a Commissioner's Deed to Mrs. Vina Pullen Adams, on Lots Number Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), in Block Ten (10), of Hot Springs Addition to the Town of Saratoga. Also Deed to Hugh Glasgow on Lots Number Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), in Block Number Seven (7), in the Town of Baggs. The applicants having paid all taxes, interest and penalties due on said property.

On request of the State Highway Department, it was decided to start condemnation proceedings to secure a right-of-way for the Lincoln Highway between the Town of Parco and Walcott. Therefore, it was regularly moved by Penn L. Gooldy, seconded by Frank Schilt, and duly carried, that the County Clerk prepare and advertise the initiatory notice.
