Special Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners called for the adoption of plans for the One Hundred Ninety Foot (190') Steel Bridge over Snake River near Dixon Wyoming. On motion by W. M. Englehart seconded by C. W. Morgan and duly carried it was decided to accept the revisions on the plans as suggested by the American Bridge Company and as shown by their plans No. W. H. 107 C, on file in this office. These revisions being acceptable to the contractor J. F. Turpen and without any additional cost to the County of Carbon.

Motion duly made and carried to accept the bids of Jarrell & Son to grade the hills on Antelope and Indian Creeks east of Encampment.

There being nothing before the Board it was regularly adjourned to meet on November 3rd at 10 O'clock A. M. 1926.
