Carbon County Fair

At a meeting of the County Fair and Rodeo Board several months ago it was decided to definitely separate the County Fair from the Rodeo and at a meeting held in the office of County Agent McElroy, June 8th, the County Fair was discussed at length.

The County Commissioners and the Fair Board were supported by the members of the Board of Carbon County Taxpayers League in their decision to have a County Fair this fall. Any show or rodeo being held at that time will be conducted by outside interests.

Salaries of County Employees

Continuing their efforts to curtail expenses of the County, the Board made the following reductions in salaries of County employees, effective July 1st. Deputy Sheriffs of the following localities were removed from the regular salary list and will serve papers only on authority from the sheriff's office, Baggs, Saratoga, Elk Mountain,

McFadden and Lamont.

Secretaries of the County Attorney, County Agent and Deputy County Superintendent of Schools each \$25.00 reduction, assistant to the County Assessor \$10.00 reduction and Jailor \$15.00 reduction. Salaries of the regular ^{County}/road employees each \$25.00 reduction.
