

S P E C I A L S E S S I O N

The Board of County Commissioners met this 12th day of April, 1933, in Special Session to prepare for the Election to be held May 15th, 1933 at 10 o'clock A. M. in each of the election precincts.

The election purpose of which is to elect delegates to a County Convention to be held on May 18, 1933, which County Convention will in turn elect delegates to a State convention to be held on May 25th at Casper, Wyoming to consider the question of the approval or disapproval of the proposed amendment to the Eighteenth Amendment of the Constitution of the United States.

On motion of Dan Kinnaman seconded by Glen Penland and duly carried the special election will be held on May 15th, 1933 in all of the election precincts in Carbon County, Wyoming.

The Republican chairman and Democratic chairman met with the Board, whereupon one Republican and one Democrat Precinct Committeeman was chosen from each election precinct, said chosen Precinct Committeemen to receive all the instructions and data necessary to carry on the special election.

There being nothing further to come before the Commissioners at this time the meeting regularly adjourned to meet again May 2nd, 1933.
