WHEREAS, certain protests, objections and claims for damages have been made and filed against the establishment and construction of the proposed Riverside-State Line Road by persons owning or interested in the real property traversed thereby, the proposed route thereof having been described at length in the petition therefore and in the plat and field notes thereof, filed in the office of the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, on the 13th day of February, 1934.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that A. B. Campbell, Fred Hansen and A. E. Dahl, three disinterested electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, be and they are hereby appointed appraisers, to view the proposed route of the Riverside-State Line Road and the real estate traversed thereby, on Monday, the 7th day of May, A. D., 1934; they to fix the amount of the damages sustained by said claimants, to perform their other duties as provided in Section 52-221, Wyoming, Compiled Statutes 1931, and to file and report their doings in writing with the County Clerk of Carbon County, as by law required within thirty days after the date of their appointment.

Motion unanimously adopted by said board on May 2, 1934.
