Resolution.

Upon motion of Glenn Penland, Seconded by Dan Kinnaman and duly carried a Resolution was unanimously adopted, regulating the sale or keeping for sale of beer, ale, porter or wine containing four per centum or less of alcohol by volume in Carbon County, Wyoming, defining terms used therein and providing for the issuance and revocation of licenses therefore.
