A large delegation consisting of several members of the Chamber of Commerce and other prominent taxpayers of Carbon County met with the Board and asked for the construction of a road from the Jack Creek Ranger Station to Saratoga. The matter was taken under advisement.

Petition for Road

The petition of certain residents of Carbon County, State of Wyoming, for the establishment of a public road to be known as Project No. 174 B, Cb-6, Walcott-Saratoga road, commencing at a point which is 3428.0 feet N. 40° 09' W. of a point which is 1023.8 feet N. 24° 02' W. of a point which is 233.1 feet S. 89° 33' W. of the SE Cor. Sec. 35, T. 21 N. R. 84 W. of the 6th P. M., Wyoming. Thence in a southerly direction through Sec. 35, T. 21 N., R. 84 W; Sections 3, 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35, T. 20 N., R. 84 W; Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35, T. 19 N., R. 84 W; Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26, 35 and 36 T. 18 N. R. 84 W; and Sec. 1, T. 17 N., R.

84 W., to a point which is 2214.7 feet S. 1° 24' W. of a point which is 466.4 feet S. 2° 26' E. of a point which is 1455.7' N. 89° 59' W. of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of said Sec. 1, T. 17 N., R. 84 W. having been filed in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Carbon County, Wyoming, at Rawlins, on May 4th, 1935, and a list having been filed on the same date with said petition purporting to contain the names and known Post Office addresses of each person owning or interested in the land across which the establishment of said proposed road is requested, was brought up for consideration at this time.

After due consideration thereof, it was moved by Frank Schilt and seconded by Gus Larson, that S. S. Sharp be appointed Viewer of the proposed road and to report immediately as by law required.

Viewer's Report

Having been duly filed in
The report of S. S. Sharp, the viewer appointed to view the proposed Walcott-Saratoga road, was brought up for discussion at this time. After duly considering same, it was moved by Frank Schilt, seconded by Gus Larson, that said proposed Walcott-Saratoga road be laid out and established as in the petition therefore requested. Said motion was regularly adopted.

It was regularly moved by Frank Schilt, seconded by Gus Larson, that Thursday June 6th, 1935, be set as the day, at noon thereof, on or before which day all objections to the establishment or alteration of the proposed Walcott-Saratoga Road, and claims for damages therefore, shall be filed with the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, and that due notice thereof as required by law, shall be given by publication in the Rawlins Republican, a newspaper of general circulation for three successive weeks. Motion adopted.

It was then regularly moved by Frank Schilt and seconded by Gus Larson, which motion was adopted, that the County Clerk send by registered mail, with return receipts requested, a copy of the published notice to all persons of record owning lands or claiming any interest in any lands traversed by said proposed Walcott-Saratoga Road.

Liquor License.

The Application for Retail Liquor License or Malt Beverage Permit of Thomas Love, being duly approved, on motion of Frank Schilt, seconded by Gus Larson, the County Clerk was requested to issue said License to Mr. Love upon receipt of \$500.00

On verbal agreement, the Board of County Commissioners reassured Mr. Love that if Hanna should incorporate in the meantime, the balance of the \$500.00, could be applied on the City license.

On motion of the Board made and carried the Application for Malt Beverage License of John Engstrom & Frank T. Knapp, Co-Partners, was approved.

County Planning Board

At the request of the State Planning Board, a Carbon County Planning Board was established at this time and by motion made and carried a Resolution was adopted whereby local planning boards were appointed in six different districts, namely Rawlins, Platte Valley, Elk Mountain, Medicine Bow, Hanna & Snake River. The five members appointed on this County Planning Board are John J. McElroy, Chairman, H. Breitenstein, to represent Rawlins District, P. L. Gooldy, to represent Snake River District, S. S. Sharp to represent Platte Valley District, and Worth Garetson to represent Medicine Bow District.

The Board will support projects in which the County is interested to the State Board, for its consideration.
