A right-of way covering part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 14 N., R. 82 W, for the construction of a portion of the Riverside-Colorado State Line road, was granted to Carbon County, by W. N. Toothaker and a Quit Claim Deed covering same was duly executed by the said W. N. Toothaker with the provision

that Carbon County pay to the said W. M. Toothaker a claim for \$55.90. Claim was allowed.

County Assessor, County Treasurer, County Clerk, Treasurer Memorial Hospital, Justices of the Peace, Rawlins, Baggs, Hanna and Encampment.

A set of rules and regulations concerning Road and Bridge employees was drawn up at this time and notices to that effect were prepared and mailed to the different road and bridge employees. The said notices to read as follows:

NOTICE TO COUNTY EMPLOYEES

1. Effective at once Road and Bridge Employees of Carbon County will work eight (8) hours per day, 8:00 A. M. to 5:00 P. M. on the job, not including time going to and returning from the place of working.
2. No employee is to take, for private use, any gas, oil, repairs, or other county property or service.
3. The watchman will fill county trucks with what is needed, and each employee must go to the watchman for that purpose. The watchman will keep an accurate account of all disbursements of oil and gas, and any other materials, and will report to the County Commissioners each month with a statement of the same.
4. The County will not pay meals and expenses of employees, but will pay only the wages due.
5. No employee shall charge any bill to the County without authority from the Commissioners.
6. The watchman on the grounds will be responsible for the safekeeping and accounting for all property of the County in his care.
