

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met this 15th day of November, A. D. 1938, at 12:00 o'clock P.M., with all members of the Board present. The purpose of the meeting to fix wage schedule for Carbon County Court House.

Commissioner Larson introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Motion seconded by Fred Hansen and unanimously carried that said resolution be adopted.

" RESOLUTION FIXING  
MINIMUM WAGE RATES  
FOR ADDITIONAL LABOR CLASSIFICATIONS"

WHEREAS, a thorough investigation has been made of the hourly wage rates which are being paid in the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming which is the locality in which the proposed project of new Courthouse and Jail Building is to be constructed by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, to employees in each trade or occupation engaged in work of a nature similar to the work to be performed in the construction of said Project, and the prevailing hourly wage rates being paid in such locality to such employees for such work have been determined by consultation with local contractors and by making inquiry of the Central Labor Union as to local prevailing wage scales, and by consultation with craftsmen of the several crafts operating in this vicinity, no Project of a similar nature under similar conditions having been recently constructed in this locality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming that the following rates for the respective trades or occupations listed below shall be and are hereby fixed as the minimum hourly wage rates and have been determined in accordance with rates prevailing for work of a similar nature in the locality in which the Project is to be constructed:

Shovel Operator			\$1.00
Caterpillar Operator			.80
Truck Driver (2 Ton or less)			.50
Truck Driver (Over 2 Ton)			.65

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing list of trades or occupations includes to the best of our knowledge, all the classifications of employees who will be engaged in work on said Project other than executive, supervisory, administrative, clerical or other non-manual workers as such."

Submitted by H. J. Cashman a letter stating he had sub-contracted to Anderson & Johnson excavation work in the amount of \$3914.86. Upon motion duly made the said sub-contractor was duly approved and the clerk was authorized to notify the PWA office to that effect.

No further business appearing meeting was regularly adjourned until Tuesday, December 6th, 1938
