RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT CHANGE
FOR
CARBON COUNTY COURTHOUSE
RAWLINS, WYOMING

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, as follows:

1. That it is deemed advisable and for the best interest of said County that the contract between the said County and the Spiegelberg Lumber and Building Company, Contractors, covering work on the Carbon County Courthouse and Jail Building Project of said County, be changed in the following respects:

(a) Wording on PWA signs be changed from "Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works" to "Federal Works Agency, Public Works Administration." -6.00

- (b) Facing of north garden wall be made of face brick to match that in the Courthouse Building, rather than of native stone, which under the present contract, was agreed to have been furnished and installed. - 00.00
- (c) Face Brick be omitted in tool house and cinder tile substituted therefor, and smooth cement plaster be applied to face of tile on all walls in tool house room. Credit-93.00
- (d) Change all Flagstone coping under wrought iron grilles of area ways and south garden wall from Flagstone to Portland cement mortar, cast in place with facing material mixed with white Portland cement. 00.00
- (e) Raising North end of north garden wall. 46.20
- (f) Eight telephone extensions- 112.00


2. That it is hereby determined that all the data necessary to obtain a comprehensive and intelligent bid, which data, prepared and assembled by Frederic Hutchinson Porter, are referred to herein and made a part hereof, were properly submitted to said Contractor with a request that such Contractor submit a proposal to said County covering such proposed changes.

3. That the proposal of said Contractor, a copy of which is hereto attached, and made a part hereof, to make the said changes, and accept therefor an increase in the contract price of Seventy One & -----20/100 (\$71.20.) be and the same is hereby accepted for and in behalf of said County.

4. That such acceptance of the Contractor's proposal shall become effective only when a certified copy of this resolution is sent to the Contractor by the Architect.

School Treasurer's bond in the amount of \$1000.00 for Mary Sharp, School District No. 12 was duly approved and placed on file.

There being no further business to come before the Board, motion was made by Commissioner McCarthy and seconded by Goldy that meeting adjourn.
