The monthly reports of County officers were audited and approved.

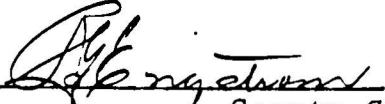

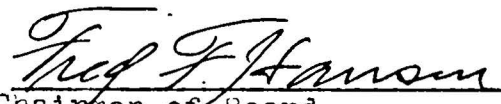
