THE BOARD RESUMED ITS SESSION OCTOBER 2, 1940, ALL MEMBERS PRESENT, FRED F. HANSEN, CHAIRMAN.

THE BOND OF A. F THODE FOR \$25,000.00 AS TREASURER OF SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 3 WAS APPROVED.

THE MONTHLY REPORTS OF COUNTY OFFICERS WERE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE.

IN COMPLIANCE WITH INSTRUCTIONS FROM GOVERNOR NELS SMITH, THE BOARD AUTHORIZED THE COUNTY CLERK TO MAKE ALL NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SELECTIVE SERVICE DRAFT REGISTRATION TO BE HELD OCTOBER 16, 1940, AT ALL REGULAR VOTING PRECINCTS, HOSPITALS, JAILS AND STATE INSTITUTIONS.

SEVERAL MATTERS OF ROUTINE COUNTY BUSINESS WERE DISPOSED OF.

THE MEETING ADJOURNED UNTIL OCTOBER 3, 1940.

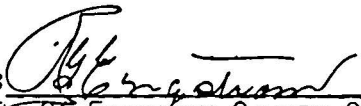

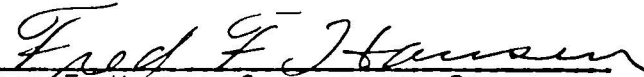
