

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

REGULAR MEETING

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET NOV. 7, 1940 AT 10:00 O'CLOCK A. M. ALL MEMBERS PRESENT, FRED F. HANSEN, PRESIDING.

THE MINUTES OF MEETINGS HELD OCT. 1 AND 18 WERE READ AND APPROVED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER GOOLDY AND SECONDED BY MCCARTHY, TO INCREASE THE JUSTICE COURT BUDGET FOR THE CURRENT YEAR, \$100.00 ACCOUNT OF UNEXPECTED COURT COSTS, THIS AMOUNT TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM UNAPPROPRIATED REVENUES IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 11, CHAPTER 87, SESSION LAWS OF WYOMING, 1939.

COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER, DR. RAYMOND BARBER REQUESTED THAT SUFFICIENT FUNDS BE ADDED TO THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER'S BUDGET TO TAKE CARE OF BILLS UNTIL THE END OF 1940. AN EPIDEMIC OF VARIOUS DISEASES DURING MARCH, APRIL AND MAY OF 1940, CAUSED EXTRA EXPENSES IN THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND DEPLETED THIS BUDGET. IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 11, CHAPTER 87, SESSION LAWS OF WYOMING 1939, THE BOARD UNANIMOUSLY APPROPRIATED \$650.00 FOR THIS DEPARTMENT.

IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 11, CHAPTER 87, SESSION LAWS OF WYOMING 1939, A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER GOOLDY, SECONDED BY MCCARTHY AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT \$10,000 BE ADDED TO THE ROAD AND BRIDGE DEPARTMENT BUDGET FOR 1940. THIS BUDGET WAS DEPLETED ON ACCOUNT OF HEAVY RAINS THAT CAUSED WASHING OUT OF ROADS AND BRIDGES, NECESSITATING EXTRA EXPENSE IN THIS DEPARTMENT.
