On motion made by McCarthy, second by Hansen and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted by the Board, in compliance with Court Order from the Second Judicial District;

O R D E R

WHEREAS, the District Court of the Second Judicial District in and for the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, entered an order on September 27, 1941, holding that School District No. 7 in Carbon County, Wyoming, levied an illegal levy for a sinking fund for a new school building for the years 1940 and 1941, and said levy was assessed against all taxable property in said school district.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, hereby order the County Treasurer of Carbon County to refund to the taxpayers of said district the portion thereof found to be illegal.
