



COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Special Meeting

The Board of Commissioners met February 21, 1941, at 1:00 o'clock P. M., all members present, John F. Gooldy presiding.

County Surveyor, S. S. Sharp, submitted his report as viewer of the proposed changes in Hanna-Rock River portion of Lincoln Highway Number 30.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hansen, seconded by McCarthy and unanimously carried, adopting the following resolution:

WHEREAS,

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as Hanna-Rock River, commencing at a point which is on the east boundary of Section 20, T. 22 N., R. 77 W., of the 6th P. M., Wyoming and from which point the east 1/4 corner of said Section 20 bears S. 0°26' W., 328.5 feet. Thence westerly through Sections 20 and 19, T. 22 N., R. 77 W., Sections 24, 13, 14, 15, 10, 9, 8 and 7, T. 22 N., R. 78 W., Sections 12, 11, 10, 2, 3 and 4, T. 22 N., R. 79 W., to a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 4, which point is N. 65°41' W., 2641.0 feet of a point which is N. 76°13' W., 2477.0 feet of a point from which the southeast corner of said Section 4 bears S. 0°12' W., 1332.9 feet.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on Map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

All objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 26 day of March, A. D., 1941, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
