Regular Meeting

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Hansen and unanimously carried, to-wit:

Road

Be it resolved by The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County that a portion of the Hanna-Leo Road be, and the same is hereby declared a County Road, with Right-of-Way 80 feet on each side of a center-line described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Twp., 23 N., R. 81 W., located S. 50° 5' W., 2218 feet from the northeast corner of said Section 33;

Running thence in a general northerly direction through the following described lands:

- W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33;
- W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 28;
- NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 29;
- E $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec. 20;
- SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 17;
- W $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec. 16;
- W $\frac{1}{2}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9;
- E $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec. 4; All in Twp. 23 N., R. 81 W;
- W $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec. 34, Twp. 24 N., R. 81 W.

Terminating at a point in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Twp. 24 N., R. 81 W., located S. 44° 50' E. 1625 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 34.
