

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met April 7, 1942, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., all present, John F. Gooldy presiding.

The minutes of meeting held March 3rd were read and approved.

There being no protests entered, liquor license No. 18 was issued to Orval A. Dart of Lamont, for the sum of \$300.00. This license was formerly held by Robinson & O'Donnell.

There being no protests entered, a malt beverage license No. 90 was issued to Joe Quintana of Walcott, for the sum of \$100.00.
