COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met Feb. 5, 1945, at 10:00 A. M., all members present, for the final adoption of the County Budget for 1945.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough, and unanimously carried, whereby the following resolutions were adopted.

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 18 day of Dec., 1944, R. G. Engstrom, the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the year 1945; and

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Carbon County News, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county, for three consecutive weeks prior to the 5th day of February, 1945; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in said proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the year 1945.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the year 1945 and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.
