SAVERY-SLATER ROAD PROJECT S-43 (3) A.F.E. 2467

It was regularly moved by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Cheesbrough, and unanimously carried, that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION TO LOCATE ROAD.

WHEREAS, public necessity requires that the following road be established;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that the following described road be located and established as follows, to-wit:

Project No. S-43 (3).

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming have decided to locate a road to be known as Savery-Slater Road, Commencing at a point which is the center of Section 7, T. 12 N., R. 89 W. of the 6th P.M. Wyoming; thence running in an east and southeasterly direction through sections 7, 8, 9, 16, and 15, T. 12 N., R. 89 W., a distance of 3.956 miles to a point on the Wyoming-Colorado line, from which point the southeast corner of section 15, T. 12 N., R. 89 W. bears S. $89^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}'$ E., a distance of 995.1 feet.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on Map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

All objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 7 day of July A.D. 1948, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

At the regular June 1948 meeting of the Board of County Commissioners the State Highway Engineer J. E. Graham and J. J. Hickey, County Attorney, met with the board regarding road project known as the Rawlins-Medicine Bow Project FI-221 (2).

The record of the Board of Commissioners shows that on the fourth day of March 1948, the Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution to locate the above mentioned road, description thereof having been filed in the office of the County Clerk. It further appeared that registered letters were mailed to all land owners, stating that objections thereto and claims for damages should be filed in writing with County Clerk before noon on April 7, 1948, or the road would be established without reference to objections or claims filed thereafter.

On March 4, 11, and 18, 1948, notice of location of public road was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, describing in particular the Rawlins-Medicine Bow Project. Protests and Claims of damages were received from the Chace Bros., Dana Meadows Sheep Company, and Andy Nelson Sheep Company. Then on the seventh day of April, 1948 the Board of County Commissioners appointed Frank Schilt, A. E. Robertson, and W. J. Scott to view the proposed road and fix the amount of damages sustained by the claimants, allowing for all benefits for each claimant by reason of the location of the proposed road. On April 13, 1948, the appraisers submitted the following report:

Less damage equalling one-half of the value of land or one-half of \$2754.00 being \$1377.00, total to Dana Meadows Sheep Co. \$1549.41.

The report also contained a recommendation that fences, under-passes, reservoirs, wagon road approaches all be graded and gated where necessary for all claimants.

At their meeting on April 20, 1948, the Board of Commissioners accepted the report of appraisers on the said road, and adopted said report with the amendment that the Dana Meadows Sheep Company should be awarded damages in the amount of \$2926.41 rather than that recommended by the appraisers on the acreage basis.

The following motion was therefore made by Commissioner Eugene McCarthy, seconded by Commissioner Cheesbrough and unanimously carried and moved that the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners have adopted the report and recommendation of the appraisers made on the twentieth day of April, 1948, with the amendment that Dana Meadows Sheep Company be allowed damages in the amount of \$2926.41, instead of \$1549.41,

AND WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners have recommended the fencing, underpass, reservoir, and wagon road approaches to be graded and gated where necessary to the State Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the above set out road be established and that the Highway Department be notified of this action.
