COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS
REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 A.M., all members present, Eugene McCarthy, Chairman.

The minutes of meetings held May, 1, 2, 12, 18, and 24, 1951, were read and approved.

SURVEYOR - APPOINTMENT: S. S. Sharp of Saratoga, Wyo., was appointed as County Surveyor, effective January 2, 1951 for a four-year period ending January 3, 1955, at \$12.00 per diem.

PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR: County License No. 2724 was granted to Marylee Moore of Rawlins as a Private Investigator for a period of one year, ending June 6, 1952 for the sum of \$60.00.

UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP: A request was received by the Board from Kenneth Gaskell of Hanna, Wyo. for a University Scholarship. A letter was also received together with a transcript of credits from J. F. Jiacolletti, Superintendent of Schools of Hanna, recommending this application. In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 74, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1941, a Scholarship is hereby granted to Mr. Gaskell for the year 1951-1952, with unanimous approval of the Board of Commissioners.

PASS CREEK ROAD:

A delegation of ranchers from Pass Creek composed as follows, Len Walker, William Fitzgerald, and Raymond Ault, met with the Board to discuss the Pass Creek Road. This delegation presented a petition signed by eleven property owners of this area containing a request that the County Commissioners take such action as will become necessary to establish a County Road between the town of Elk Mountain and a point on Highway No. 130, between Walcott and Saratoga, Wyoming.

APPOINTMENT OF VIEWER: In compliance with Section 48-309, W.C.S. 1945, George R. Salisbury, Jr., was appointed as viewer of the proposed Pass Creek Road.

REPORT OF VIEWER: In compliance with Section 48-312, a Viewer's Report signed by George R. Salisbury, Jr., was presented to the Board and placed on file.

SURVEY AND RECORD OF PASS CREEK ROAD: In compliance with Section 48-314, W.C.S. 1945, a survey and plat of the proposed Pass Creek Road was presented to the Board by County Surveyor, S. S. Sharp, and placed on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The following resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board, to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is at present a road from Elk Mountain, Wyoming to a point on Wyoming Highway 130 between Saratoga, Wyoming and Walcott, Wyoming, part of which said road has been in existence for many years and been maintained by the County for many years, and

WHEREAS, the validity of said road as a County Highway has been challenged, and,

WHEREAS, the great majority of owners of the land over which said road passes have given their written consent to said road, and,

WHEREAS, public interest and necessity requires that said road be a County Highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, on its own Motion, that the following County Highway, to be known as Pass Creek Road, be located, altered, and established as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point of intersection with Wyoming Highway No. 130 located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 19 N., Range 84 W., in Carbon County, Wyoming, which point is located N. 46° 12' W. 2280' from the East quarter corner of said Section 14.

Running thence in a general easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 14, 13 and 24, T. 19 N., R. 84 W., Sections 19, 30, 20, 29, 21, 28, 33, 27, 34, 26, 35, and 36, T. 19 N., R. 83 W., Sections 31, 32, 33, 28, 27, 26, 25 and 36, T. 19 N., R. 82 W., Sections 31, 32, 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W., and Section 5, T. 18 N., R. 81 W.;

And terminating at a point on the present county road in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W., which point is located S. 72° 39' E. 276 feet from a point located N. 60° 52' E. 812 feet from the south quarter corner of said Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W.

The width of right of way required is 150 feet, being 75 feet on either side of the above center line, from the point of beginning to the west line of Sections 27 and 34, T. 19 N., R. 83 W., and 100 feet in width, being 50 feet on either side of the center line, from the west line of said Sections 27 and 34, T. 19 N., R. 83 W., to the point of termination in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W. ~~and the center line of the said road~~ The Board of Commissioners hereby ordered that the following Notice of Location of Road be published in compliance with Section 48-316, W.C.S., 1945:

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD (PASS CREEK ROAD)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming have decided to locate and alter a road to be known as PASS CREEK ROAD to commence at a point in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T. 19 N. R. 84 W., in Carbon County, Wyoming, which point is located N. 46° 12' W., 2280 feet from the east quarter-corner of said Section 14, T. 19 N., R. 84 W., running thence in a general easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 14, 13, and 24, T. 19 N., R. 84 W., Sections 19, 30, 20, 29, 21, 28, 33, 27, 34, 26, 35, and 36, T. 19 N., R. 83 W., Sections 31, 32, 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W., and Section 5, T. 18 N., R. 81 W., and terminating at a point on the present county road in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W., which point is located S. 72° 39' E., 276 feet from a point located N. 60° 52' E. 812 feet from the south quarter-corner of said Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W.

The width of right-of-way required is 150 feet, being 75 feet on either side of the above center line, from the point of beginning to the west line of Sections 27 and 34, T. 19 N., R. 83 W., and 100 feet in width, being 50 feet on either side of the center line, from the west line of said Sections 27 and 34, T. 19 N., R. 83 W. to the point of termination in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 81 W.

All objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 2nd day of July, A.D., 1951, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.
