PASS CREEK ROAD - REPORT OF BOARD OF APPRAISERS

The Board of Appraisers filed the report of their findings on above mentioned road in the office of the County Clerk on August 29, 1951. The Board of Commissioners, together with C.A. Brimmer and Chas. G. Vivion of the Rocky Mountain Sheep Co; G.B. Hunt, I.G. Shurigar, Rex W. Foster, and their Attorney, C.L. Bates; County Attorney, Wm. N. Brimmer, Attorney H.M. Johnson, and County Clerk, R. G. Engstrom, reviewed and discussed this report.

On motion made by Commissioner Salisbury, seconded by Commissioner Cheesbrough and unanimously carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

A R E S O L U T I O N

It is hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, that the said road to be known as the Pass Creek Road be located, altered and established as set forth in the said Resolution of June 5, 1951; and that the appraisal of R.W. Taylor, Wm. H. Carey, and O.C. Sheehan which was filed in the office of the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming on the 29th day of August, 1951, be accepted and approved.

JACK CREEK SCHOOL BUS ROAD A motion was made by Commissioner Cheesbrough, seconded by Salisbury, and unanimously carried whereby the following Resolution and Order was adopted.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have been urged to construct a road to be known as the Jack Creek School Bus Road, beginning at a point located N. $43^{\circ} 36'$ W., 787 feet from the southeast corner of Section 10, T. 17 N., R. 84 W., and running in a general northwesterly direction through Section 10, 3 and 4 of said township, terminating at the present Jack Creek lane at a point located S. $1^{\circ} 13'$ E. 1999 feet from the northwest corner of Section 4, of said township; and

WHEREAS, the construction of said road appears advisable on account of winter conditions on the present road; and

WHEREAS, easements in writing have been obtained from all the owners of the lands traversed by said road;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved and ordered by said Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, that the proposed road as above described be, and the same is hereby declared to be a county road; and that the County Surveyor be instructed to plat said road in the County Road Book, and to file the notes of survey of said road in the office of the County Clerk.
