The application of the Ohio Oil Company for permission to lay one or more pipe lines along and across certain county roads in ~~xxix~~ County, Carbon County, the following Resolution was moved by Commissioner Salisbury, and seconded by Commissioner Robertson, and duly passed:

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, State of Wyoming; that, Section 1. To the extent that consent may be granted, consent is hereby granted by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, to The Ohio Oil Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, and authorized to do business in the State of Wyoming, and its successors and assigns, to lay, maintain and operate one or more pipe lines along, over and across the several highways of this said County that may be traversed, intersected or crossed by the following route:

By a line running from a point in the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 16, T. 21 N., R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming, thence in a general southeasterly direction to a point on the Trigood-Baker lease in the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 26, T. 21 N., R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming. Said pipe line crosses the Medicine Bow-Rock River county road in the following location:

Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 16, T. 21 N., R. 78 W.

Section 2. The Above consent is granted upon the following express conditions:

That all pipe lines laid under this grant shall be buried in the ground so as to be not less than two feet beneath the surface in borrow pits of said road or highway.

As said lines or any portion thereof are constructed along or across any of the highways, the roadway or place where the same is constructed shall at once be restored to as good condition as the same was in immediately preceding the commencing of such construction and for the purpose for which such place or surface was then being used. Said construction shall at all times be carried on in such a manner as to safeguard the public using said highway and at no time shall said company cause traffic to be stopped or highways to be closed for a longer time than necessary in each case.

Said pipe lines shall be so constructed and maintained as not to interfere with or impair the use of said highways and ditches, drains and culverts in connection therewith for travel by the public or for drainage or sewerage.

In case the said Board of County Commissioners or their successors in office shall at any time or from time to time determine to improve in any manner or alter or change the grade, route or materials of said roads or ditches, sewers, drains or culverts and the same shall involve the changing of said pipe lines in any manner, then such changes shall be made in said pipe lines as may be necessary as said County Commissioners or their successors shall direct by the said company at once, and at its expense.

This Resolution and all its terms and conditions shall be and are hereby binding and obligatory on the successors of said Board of County Commissioners or other officer or officers that may succeed in law to the charge of said public highways or any part thereof, and on the successors and assigns of said Company and all persons, or corporations holding by, through or under it.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from the date thereof.

I hereby certify that the resolution of which the foregoing is a copy, was duly passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, State of Wyoming, on the 5th day of August, A.D. 1953, at a regular monthly meeting of said Board in the City of Rawlins, Wyoming.
