RAWLINS-MEDICINE BOW CARBON COUNTY PROJECT NO. I-221 (6)

At the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyo., held Jan. 7, 1953 a motion was made by Commissioner Salisbury, seconded by Robertson, and was duly passed to adopt the following resolution.

WHEREAS: The Board of County Commissioners deem that the public interest requires that a road be established, to be known as Rawlins-Medicine Bow Road, Wyoming Project I-221 (6), commencing at a point on the north boundary of section 30, T. 21 N., R. 83 W. from which the northeast corner of said section 30 bears easterly a distance of 2381.4 feet; thence running in a southwesterly direction through section 30, T. 21 N., R. 83 W.; sections 25, 26, 35, 36, 34, 33, 32 and 31, T. 21 N., R. 84 W., and section 36, T. 21 N., R. 85 W., to a point on the west boundary of section 36, T. 21 N., R. 85 W., from which point the northwest corner of said section 36 bears N. 0° 41' E. a distance of 1618.6 feet.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of County Commissioners declare their intention to establish said road by publication of a Notice of Location and by mailing a copy of said notice, by registered mail, to all persons owning lands or claiming any interest in lands over or across which said road is to be located, and that said notice shall state that all objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of Carbon County before noon on the 10th day of February A.D. 1953; or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

THEREUPON THE BOARD ADJOURNED SUBJECT TO THE CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN.
