COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS  
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 a.m., Cheesbrough and Robertson present, Salisbury absent.

MEDICINE-NORTH ROAD: A motion was made by Robertson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, did, on the 7th day of April, 1954, adopt a resolution declaring their intention to establish a road to be known as the Medicine Bow-North road, Wyoming Project No. S- 50 (8), described as follows:

Commencing at a point in Section 21, T. 24 N., R. 78 W. of the 6th P. M. Wyoming, which point is N. 5° 41' W. a distance of 259.9 feet from a point which is N. 9° 49' E. a distance of 2569.9 feet from a point on the South boundary of said section 21, from which the southwest corner thereof bears S. 89° 50' W. a distance of 1052.3 feet;

thence running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately seven miles through sections 21, 16, 17, 8, 9, 4 and 5, T. 24 N., R. 78 W., and sections 33, 28, 21 and 16 in T. 25 N., R. 78 W., to a point of ending on the west boundary of section 16, T. 25 N., R. 78 W. from which the west quarter corner of said section 16 bears southerly a distance of 203.0 feet, and,

WHEREAS: All claims filed having been satisfied and easements secured covering all lands,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the road as described above and shown in detail on map on file in the office of the County Clerk of said County, be and is hereby declared established.

RAWLINS MEDICINE BOW ROAD Project FI 221 (7), A motion was made by Robertson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, did, on the 3rd day of March, 1954, adopt a resolution declaring their intention to establish a road to be known as the Rawlins-Medicine Bow road, Project FI 221 (7), described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east boundary of Section 16, T. 21 N., R. 83 W. of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, from which the northeast corner of said Section 16 bears northerly a distance of 1700.8 feet;

thence running in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approximately three miles through Sections 16, 21, 20 and 19, T. 21 N., R. 83 W., to a point on the south boundary of said Section 19 from which the southeast corner thereof bears easterly a distance of 2381.4 feet; and,

WHEREAS, the following claims for damages were filed by owners of lands crossed:

## JARDA ELIZABETH NELSON ESTATE:

The sum of \$237.00 for 23.7 acres land taken for right of way.

Right of way to be fenced both sides with standard gage 26 inch woven wire and two barbed wire spaced 4" and 16" above the woven wire.

Approach to be constructed between the new road and the present road at approximately Station 2020. The 108" or larger pipe planned at Station 2028 to be fenced for a stock pass.

Double gates to be constructed on each side approximate Station 2130.

## GERTRUDE ANDERSON:

The sum of \$302.00 for 30.2 acres land taken for right of way.

Standard four wire fence constructed both sides. South fence to be constructed before grading work is begun. Gates and approaches to be built where necessary. Fence to be constructed around filling station site near Station 2064. Two 30 ft. top width approaches, location to be determined and built to satisfaction of owner.

A sleeve to be installed six feet deep at approximately Station 2079 large enough to accommodate a a two-inch water pipe.

A 132-inch multiplate corrugated metal pipe to be installed at approximately Station 2089, the pipe to be fenced for stockway.

## ANDREW R. ANDERSON ESTATE:

The sum of \$161.00 for 16.1 acres land taken for right of way.

Standard four wire fence to be constructed on both sides, the south side to be constructed before grading is begun.

Proper approaches to be constructed to give access across the road at approx. Station 2102. Gates to be placed where necessary.

Proposed multiplate pipe at Station 2091 to be fenced for a stock pass, and a 72" corrugated metal pipe to be installed at approximately Station 2096.

WHEREAS, the claims as filed are, in the opinion of said Board, just and reasonable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the claims as filed and summarized above be allowed and the road as described above and shown in detail on plans on file with the said County be and is hereby declared established and the Chairman of said Board be hereby authorized to prepare and file certificates of right of way with the County Clerk of said County for recording as authorized by Section 3 (e) of Chapter 181, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1953.

SINCLAIR-PLATTE RIVER ROAD: A motion was made by Robertson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, did on April 13, 1954 adopt a resolution declaring intent to establish road to be known as Sinclair-Platte River Road, described in Notice of Public Road on record in office of County Clerk - Commissioners Record No. 10, Page 536, and

WHEREAS, all land owners affected by said proposed road have been notified by registered mail, and

WHEREAS, the date of filing objections or claims for damages expired at noon May 17, 1954, and

WHEREAS, no objections or claims for damages were filed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved; That the road as described in Commissioners Record No. 10 at Page 536 and shown in detail on map on file in the office of the County Clerk of said County, be and is hereby declared established.
