- The following description of the location of SC-CFM 3781 (Sinclair-Recreation Park) is to supersede the description as shown in the agreement of SC-CFM 3781 dated May 5, 1954.
- Commencing at a point on the Sinclair-Seminole Dam road approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north of the Town of Sinclair in Sec. 16, T. 21 N., R. 86 W., thence in a northeasterly direction thru Section 16, 15, 14, 11, 12 and 1, T. 21 N., R. 86 W., and into Section 6, T. 21 N., R. 85 W., a distance of approximately 5.098 miles.
- The right-of-way for this project has been secured and records are on file in this office.
- Thereupon the Board adjourned until the following day.
