MONTHLY REPORTS of County Officers were audited and placed on file.

A motion was made by Commissioner Robertson, Seconded by Salisbury and unanimously carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, deem the public interest requires that a road be established, to be known as the Rawlins - Medicine Bow Road, Wyoming Project FI - 221 (7),

Commencing at a point on the east boundary of Section 16, T. 21 N., R. 83 W. of the 6th P. M., Wyoming, from which the northeast corner of said section 16 bears northerly a distance of 1700.8 feet;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approximately three miles through Sections 16, 21, 20 and 19, in T. 21 N., R. 83 W.,

to a point on the south boundary of said section 19 from which the southeast corner thereof bears easterly a distance of 2381.4 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the said Board do hereby initiate the procedure for the establishment of said road, and declare their intention to establish said road, by following out the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 48, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945 as amended, not inconsistent therewith.

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming have decided to locate a road to be known as the Rawlins - Medicine Bow Road, Wyoming Project FI - 221 (7),

Commencing at a point on the east boundary of Section 16, T. 21 N., R. 83 W. of the 6th P. M., Wyoming, from which the northeast corner of said section 16 bears northerly a distance of 1700.8 feet;

Thence running in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approximately three miles through Sections 16, 21 20 and 19, in T. 21 N., R. 83 W.,

to a point on the south boundary of said section 19 from which the southeast corner thereof bears easterly a distance of 2381.4 feet.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

Any land owner or interested party desiring to raise any question with respect to the necessity of the taking of the land for road purposes shall do so by filing, within thirty days after the last publication of this notice, a petition in the District Court of the county in which the land is located. If no petition to raise the question of necessity is filed within the said thirty day period, the necessity shall be presumed and the question cannot later be raised.

All other objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said county before noon on the 7th day of April, A. D. 1954, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

SCHOOL TREASURER BOND: On January 5, 1954 the District Boundary Board consolidated School Districts 9 and 23 in Carbon County. In view of this consolidation it was moved by Commissioner Salisbury, seconded by Robertson and carried that the bond of the Treasurer for School District 9 be increased from \$16,000.00 to \$20,000.00. The bond of Harold F. Willford, Treasurer of School District 9, in the amount of \$20,000.00 was approved by the Board.

UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AGREEMENT AND RESOLUTION: Removal of poles.

A motion was made by Robertson, seconded by Salisbury and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF CARBON, STATE OF WYOMING has tendered to the UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY an agreement wherein the County agrees to indemnify the Railroad Company, as in said agreement provided, in connection with the sale and removal of approximately 345 communication poles located on and along the old right of way of the Railroad Company in Carbon County, Wyoming; said agreement being identified in the records of the Railroad Company as C. D. No. 39425-3; and a copy of which is hereto attached, made a part hereof marked Exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, has said proposed agreement before it and has given it careful review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, it is considered that the best interests of said County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, will be subserved by the acceptance of said agreement:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CARBON, STATE OF WYOMING:

That the terms of the agreement submitted by the Union Pacific Railroad Company as aforesaid be, and the same are hereby, accepted in behalf of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming;

That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of said County, and that the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest said agreement and to attach to each duplicate original of said agreement a certified copy of this resolution.
