PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 1

Proposal to amend Section 12, Article 15, of said Constitution to read as follows:

"Article 15, Section 12. The property of the United States, the State, counties, cities, towns, school districts and municipal corporations, when used primarily for a governmental purpose, and public libraries, lots with the buildings thereon used exclusively for religious worship, church parsonages, church schools and public cemeteries, shall be exempt from taxation, and such other property as the legislature may by general law provide."

This proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Wyoming allows property of the Federal, State and political subdivisions thereof, to be subject to taxation in the event that such property is being used for purposes other than governmental, in order that non-governmental activities upon governmental lands can bear their fair share of the tax burden within this State.
