COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met at 10:00 A. M., all members present. The minutes of meetings held October 2nd and 3rd were read and approved.

The Board then acted as a canvassing board to canvass the returns of the Special School Bond Election, held on October 6, 1956, in School District No. 3, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, at which election there was submitted to the electors of said district the following question:

Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 3, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, be authorized to issue the negotiable coupon bonds of said district in an amount not to exceed \$1,126,000.00, for the purpose of erecting a new highschool building in said district and equipping the same, said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed four and one-half per centum per annum?

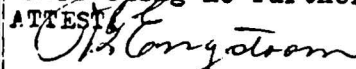
