*Road* MEDICINE BOW - CASPER ROAD, Project No. 0405. The following letter was written to the Wyoming Highway Commission.

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming approve the re-construction of the present bridge across the Medicine Bow River approximately 1.114 miles north of Medicine Bow and the reconstruction of the present bridge across the Little Medicine Bow River approximately 4.429 miles north of Medicine Bow to be constructed on a portion of the Medicine Bow-Casper road.

These bridges are approximately 0.051 miles in length and further identified as Wyoming Federal Aid Secondary Project No. 0405

The County Commissioners concur with the Wyoming Highway Commission in the selection of this project for programming with Federal Aid Secondary funds made available under the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1950.
