REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 A.M., all members present, Jackson Chairman. Minutes of meetings held April 7th and 8th were signed and approved.

FOUR MILE ROAD WEST OF BAGGS: A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following Resolution was adopted to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a country road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

FOUR MILE ROAD:

From the Town limits of Baggs, westerly and southerly thru sections 5, 7, 8 and 18, T. 12 N., R. 91 W., and section 13, T. 12 N., R. 92 W., to the Wyoming-Colorado State line.

Length approximately 3.7 miles.

Shaping, raising grade, draining and crushed gravel surfacing.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.
