BOND: The bond of Grace A. Rosier, Treasurer of Carbon County Public Library was approved in the amount of \$3000.00 for the period January 1, 1960 to December 31, 1960.

FOREST RESERVE FEES: A warrant in the amount of \$41788.19 was received by the County Treasurer from the State. In compliance with Sections 18-403 and 405 WCS 1945, a motion was made by Orton and carried whereby these fees were distributed as follows:

COUNTY GENERAL FUND \$39,698.78 SCHOOL DISTRICTS \$2089.41

ABATEMENT: Seahorn Bros. of Saratoga, Wyoming were granted an abatement in the amount of \$187.12, account of erroneous assessment.

STATE EXAMINERS REPORTS: The examiners reports for the County General, County Fair, County Library and County School Districts were received and examined by the Board. The Commissioners agreed to comply with the suggestions and recommendations of the examiners.

OIL AND GAS LEASE: The Commissioners entered into a Lease between the County and Humble Oil and Refining Co., on a portion of land in Section 11, Township 13 N., Range 89 W., 6th P.M., containing 10.91 acres for a five year period, commencing March 2, 1960 in consideration of \$54.55. A more complete description is on file in the Office of County Clerk.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
