COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 3:00 P. M., all members present, Salisbury Chairman.

The Board then proceeded to review the tentative budget requests presented for the County General, Library, Hospital, General Welfare, General Welfare Health, Fair and Bond Interest and Retirement. Several changes in the amounts requested for the tentative budgets were made. The Board adjourned until 8:00 P.M.

The Board met at 8:00 P.M., at which time all interested persons were heard relative to the budget requests. A motion was made by Patton and seconded by Salisbury and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of June, 1961, R. G. Engstrom, County Clerk, the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the 1961-1962 fiscal year ending June 30, 1962;

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county on the 18th day of July, 1961 and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified and said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in such proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1961-1962 fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1961-1962 fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.
