STOCK PILING OF GRAVEL: A motion was made by Sullins, seconded by Patton and carried whereby the following Resolution was adopted:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

- (a) Shirley Ridge road: From a point on FAS route 0405 in Sec. 3, T. 27 N., R. 80W., thence northerly & easterly to a point in Sec. 29, T. 28N., R. 78W. Length approximately 12 miles.
- (b) Little Medicine road: From a point in Sec. 16, T. 25N., R. 78W., thence northeasterly to a point in Sec. 17, T. 27N., R. 77W. Length approximately 10.5 miles.
- (c) Saratoga - 10 Mile road: From the east corporate limits of Saratoga in Sec. 12, T. 17N., R. 84W., thence southeasterly for approximately 5 miles.
- (d) Cedar Ridge road: From a point on the Saratoga-10 mile road in Sec. 16, T. 17N., R. 83W., thence southerly for approximately 5 miles.
- (e) Jack Creek road: (1) From the west corporate limits of Saratoga in Sec. 10, T. 17N., R. 84W., thence southwesterly for approximately 5.5 miles. (2) From a point approximately 1.5 miles west of the west corporate limits of Saratoga, northerly for approximately 1.5 miles.
- (f) Cow Creek road: From a point on FAP route 22-1 Sec. 5, T. 15N., R. 83W., thence westerly, southwesterly and southeasterly to a point on the north corporate limits of Encampment in Sec. 36, T. 15N., R. 84W. Length approximately 8 miles.
- (g) Baggott Bridge road: From a point on the Cow Creek road in Sec. 1, T. 15N., R. 84W., thence southeasterly and easterly for approximately 5 miles.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS by a certain Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, Carbon County, Wyoming, made and unanimously passed on September 6, 1961, the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, was authorized and directed to cause to be published Notice of Intention To Issue and Notice of Sale of Civic Center and Community Building bonds in the amount of Eighty-four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00) in denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to amend, modify and supercede said Resolution only to the extend that said bonds will be redeemed in substantially equal amounts within a period of six (6) years, the first installment of principal and interest on said bonds to be due and payable on January 1, 1963 and four (4) equal successive installments to be due on January 1, 1964, January 1, 1965, January 1, 1966 and January 1, 1967; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution as passed on September 6, 1961 shall be of full force and effect except insofar as this Resolution shall supercede the same.


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



An Agreement between the Board of County Commissioners and School District No. 3 in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming was then submitted, discussed and deliberation had thereon. It was then moved by Commissioner Sullins, seconded by Commissioner Patton and unanimously passed that the Chairman of the Board and the Clerk be authorized to execute said Agreement. It was also moved and unanimously passed that said Agreement be set forth verbatim in the minutes of the meeting.

A G R E E M E N T

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 8th day of November, 1961, by and between SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 3, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, a Wyoming Municipal corporation, hereinafter called VENDOR AND CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING, a Wyoming municipal corporation, hereinafter called VENDEE.

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Vendor is the owner of all of Block Thirty (30), Union Pacific Railroad Company's Second Addition to the City of Rawlins, together with all improvements thereon; and

WHEREAS, Vendee has at the date hereof, a written option to purchase the said real property for the sum of \$84,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Vendee desires to go upon said real property forthwith and prior to formal passing of legal title for the purpose of tearing down the abandoned school building located thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED:

November 8, 1961

1. Vendor agrees to sell and convey and Vendee agrees to purchase: All of Block Thirty (30), Union Pacific Railroad Compan's Second Addition to the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, as said Block is platted and appears of record in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds, Carbon County, Wyoming,
for the sum of Eighty-four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00).
2. Transfer of legal title shall be consummated by conveyance by Warranty Deed and payment of the purchase price in full on or before February 1, 1962.
3. Vendor covenants that the real property, the subject of this sale is free and clear of all encumbrances whatsoever, WITHOUT LIMITATION, and that said Vendor has full power and authority to sell and convey the same.
4. Vendor further covenants and agrees that Vendee, its agents, servants, employees, and contractors, or any person or persons acting for and in behalf of said Vendee shall have the right, IMMEDIATELY UPON THE EXECUTION OF THESE PRESENTS, to go upon the said real property for purposes of razing and tearing down the old Central School building. And Vendee covenants and agrees to hold Vendor free and harmless from any and all liability by reason of Vendee's demolition activities upon said premises from and after the date hereof.
5. The parties hereto agree that this instrument shall supercede the written option to purchase heretofore executed by the parties and that said written option to purchase shall be of no further legal effect.
6. It is agreed that this instrument shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
