

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

April 17, 1961

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 4:00 P.M., in special session, Chairman Salisbury, Patton and Ogburn were present. A letter of resignation was received from Commissioner Ogburn and Sheriff John Terrill. Both resignations were accepted.

SHERIFF APPOINTMENT: Charles W. Ogburn was appointed to the office of Sheriff, term, April 17, 1961 to January 7th, 1963.

COMMISSIONER APPOINTMENT: George P. Economy was appointed to fill the vacancy of Ogburn, term, April 17, 1961 to January 7, 1963.

BOND: The bond of George P. Economy was approved in the amount of \$1000.00.

WELFARE BOARD: George P. Economy was unanimously appointed to the Welfare Board to fill the un-expired term of Charles W. Ogburn, April 17, 1961 to January 7, 1963.

READER CEMETERY DISTRICT: A request from the qualified electors of above Cemetery District was received by the Board, naming the Candidates for District Trustees and setting the election day as May 20, 1961. The election will be held in Savery in the Schoolhouse. The Candidates are as follows: Francis Stocks, Rudolf Kuntz, Ralph Jons, Mike Thomas, Eldon Galloway and Josephine Danford.

CARBON COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY: The Board met with representatives of the Historical Society and a letter was presented requesting the following:

1. As presently provided by Law, the appointment of a three (3) man board of County Museum trustees or advisors.
2. The establishment of the fractional mill levy as provided by law for the "operation and maintenance and construction" of a County Museum. Action on this matter was deferred until the next regular meeting of the Board.

COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT: The Commissioners met with members of the State and County Health Department who presented a proposed budget for the next fiscal year and recommended the hiring of an assistant public health nurse. No action was taken at this meeting.

CIVIL DEFENSE: Richard Seith, Director of Civil Defense, requested the appointment of Harry S. Cashman as assistant director. Mr. Cashman's appointment was approved by the Board.

COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD: Mrs. D. L. Rusk was re-appointed to the County Library Board for term commencing July 2, 1961 and expiring July 2, 1964.
