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HANNA SCHOOL BOND: A motion was made by Niland, seconded by Salisbury and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, has transmitted a certified copy of a resolution adopted and approved by the Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, on the 18 day of November, 1964, to the County Clerk for the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby determine, that it is necessary and for the best interests of School District No. 7, and the County, and its inhabitants, to provide for the authorization and issuance of said bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$485,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to provide funds for the purpose of erecting, enlarging and equipping a school building in said District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That all action heretofore taken by the Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, and the officers of Carbon County, directed toward submitting the question of issuing the negotiable, coupon, general obligation bonds of said School District No. 7, in the aggregate principal amount of \$485,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of erecting, enlarging and equipping a school building in said School District No. 7, be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the adoption by said Board of Trustees of School District No. 7 of said resolution on the 18 day of November 1964, and all action taken pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the County Clerk shall give notice of the action hereby taken by transmitting to the Clerk of said Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, for said Board of Trustees, a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 3. That the officers of the County of Carbon be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and the resolution of the Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, passed and adopted on the 18 day of November, 1964, by the Board of Trustees of School District No. 7, Carbon County, Wyoming.

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Section 4. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 6. That by reason of the fact that said School District No. 7, Carbon County, Wyoming, is not properly or adequately supplied with school facilities, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, that this resolution is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and approval.

Section 7. That this resolution shall be entered on record in the minute book of the Board of County Commissioners, and the County Clerk is authorized and directed to carry out the provisions thereof.
