COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met in Special session there being present, John Orton, Chairman, George R. Salisbury, Jr. and John Niland. The meeting was called to order by John Orton, Chairman at 9:00 A. M.

A motion was made by Niland, seconded by Salisbury and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of Rawlins, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, has transmitted a certified copy of an ordinance adopted and approved by the Council of the City of Rawlins on the 13th day of April, 1965, to the County Clerk for the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby determine, that it is necessary and for the best interests of the City of Rawlins, and the County, and its inhabitants, to provide for the authorization of a bonded indebtedness by the City of Rawlins in the aggregate principal amount of \$250,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of supplying water to the City by extending the municipal water works system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That all action heretofore taken by the City Council of the City of Rawlins, the officers thereof, and the officers of Carbon County, directed toward supplying water to the City by extending the municipal water works system and toward submitting the question of issuing the negotiable, coupon, general obligation bonds of said City for that purpose be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the adoption by said City Council of said ordinance on the 13th day of April, 1965, and all action taken pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the County Clerk shall give notice of the action hereby taken by transmitting to the Clerk of said City of Rawlins, Wyoming, for said City Council, a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 3. That the officers of the County of Carbon be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and Ordinance No. 309, Series 1965, passed and adopted on the 13th day of April 1965, by the City Council of the City of Rawlins, Wyoming.

Section 4. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 6. That by reason of the fact that said City is not properly or adequately supplied with any of the above-designated facilities, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, that this resolution is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and approval.

Section 7. That this resolution shall be entered on record in the minute book of the Board of County Commissioners, and the County Clerk is authorized and directed to carry out the provisions hereof.

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On motion duly made, seconded and adopted, it was ordered that said resolution be approved and authenticated by the signatures of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk of Carbon County, and recorded in the records of said Board of County Commissioners and that a duly certified copy of said resolution should be transmitted by said County Clerk to the Clerk of the said City of Rawlins, Wyoming, for the City Council thereof.

There being no further business, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned.
