"Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 3 in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, be authorized to make an additional annual levy of five mills for current expenses as permitted by Section 4, Chapter 193, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1963, as amended and re-enacted by Enrolled Act No. 75, Senate, Thirty-Eighth Session of the State Legislature of the State of Wyoming, providing for an increase in allowable levies for school districts."

CARBON COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENT: A lease was executed on May 5, 1965 by and between Olson Enterprises, Inc., a Wyoming corporation, as Lessor, and the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, A body politic and corporate, as Lessee.

WITNESSETH:

That Lessor hereby leases to Lessee, and Lessee hires from Lessor, Those certain premises with the appurtenances, situate in the City of Rawlins, State of Wyoming, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A one-story building, 40 feet by 64 feet, situated on the West 48 Feet fronting on Spruce Street, and the East 132 feet fronting on Illinois Street, in the Southwest portion of an unplatte block lying East of Block Three (3) of the Second Hillside Addition to the City of Rawlins, Wyoming, in the City of Rawlins, County of Carbon, State of Wyoming.

The term shall be for ten (10) years, commencing on the 1st day of July 1965, at rent of sum of Two Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$290.00) per month, payable monthly in advance, lawful money of the United States of America, which Lessee agrees to pay to Lessor, without deduction or offset, at such place or places as may be designated from time to time by Lessor.

Additional provisions contained in this lease are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
