## CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS:

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 1 would permit the Legislature to establish subordinate courts by General Law.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 2 would distinguish Congressional Districts from Districts of the State House of Representatives.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 3 would repeal the requirement for a state census and allow the State to utilize the Federal Census.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 4 would raise the maximum county mill levy from 12 to 15 mills.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 5 would provide for a 12 mill replacement levy to help equalize school tax burdens and better distribute school tax revenues on the county level.

Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 6 would authorize the legislature to enact laws providing for the investment of trust funds.
