COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session on October 17, 1967 at 10:00 o'clock A. M.. Present were George R. Salisbury, Jr. acting chairman and John Orton. The purpose of the meeting was the public auction sale of a parcel of land situated within Tract 2, Memorial Hospital Addition to the City of Rawlins in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 21 North, Range 87 West, 6th Principal Meridian, Carbon County, Wyoming. The said land is subject to certain lease dated June 22, 1967 which appears of record in the office of the County Clerk as Instrument No. 450031 in Book 491 at Page 487. The said public auction sale had been advertised in the Rawlins Daily Times, a newspaper printed in and of general circulation in Carbon County, Wyoming on September 23, 30, October 7, 14, 1967. One bid in amount of \$500.00 was offered by Fremont Manor, Inc. the only bid obtained. After due consideration of said bid, it was regularly moved by Salisbury, seconded by Orton and unanimously carried that the said bid of Fremont Manor, Inc. be accepted and a quitclaim deed be executed and delivered to said corporation for the following described real property subject to said lease:

A parcel of land situated within Tract No. 2, Memorial Hospital Addition to the City of Rawlins; in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T. 21N., R. 87W., 6th P. M., Carbon County, Wyoming; said parcel of land more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point monumented by a cement nail, at the North-South Section line between Sections 18 & 17, said township and range, and said point at beginning bears along said Section line S. 0° 15' W. a distance of 545.66 feet from the east $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 18;

thence continuing along said Section line S. 0° 15' W. a Distance of 300.00 feet;

thence N. 88° 55' W., a distance of 150.00 feet to a point monumented by a 1"x2"x16" pine stake and tack;

thence continuing N. 88° 55' W. a distance of 250.00 feet to a point monumented by a 1"x2"x16" pine stake and tack;

thence N. 0° 15' E. a distance of 300.00 feet to a point monumented by a 1"x2"x16" pine stake and tack;

thence S. 88° 55' E. a distance of 250.00 feet to a point monumented by a 1"x2"x16" stake and tack;

thence continuing S. 88° 55' E. a distance of 150.00 feet to original point of beginning.

BOND ELECTION:

Curt E. Kaiser, Jr., a representative of Coughlin and Company, Investment Bankers of Denver, also appeared before the Board and tendered a proposal to act as fiscal agent in the upcoming hospital bond election. The said written proposal was read aloud in its entirety to the board by Mr. Kaiser. Mr. Robert Gilstrap and Joe Mullen of the hospital administration appeared with Mr. Kaiser and recommended acceptance of his proposal. After due consideration of said proposal, it was moved by Orton and seconded by Salisbury that said proposal be accepted and Coughlin and Company be engaged as fiscal agent. Said motion was unanimously carried. It was further moved, seconded and unanimously carried that said proposal be executed in duplicate this date and one executed copy be forwarded to Coughlin and Company, Inc., 1200 First National Bank Bldg., Denver, Colorado.

The commissioners also set Tuesday, December 5, 1967 as the election date for the proposed Carbon County Hospital Bond Issue in amount of \$1,000,000.00.
